



BRIEFLY FROM THE BOARD

June offering \$5,217.00, June expenses \$7,967.45, June budget \$7,458.33. Our Access Fund is currently at \$33,103.50 for the lift project — we're making progress! Committee budgets should be turned in by August board meeting. Board Chairman Dan Crum has appointed Kyle Nordyke, Gloria Graham, and himself to serve on the Pastor Relations Committee (PRC) and will be setting up time to meet with Pastor Kristin. Nancy Cumberland, church secretary, has sent resignation letter to Board Chairman Dan Crum and Pastor Kristin effective 7/31/2025. Thank you, Nancy, for serving as our secretary and doing such a great job! We really appreciate your time and efforts, all the big and little things you do to make things run smoothly! There is no plan to replace the secretary right away. We will continue to work on church bylaw revisions. Judy Watkins, CWF President, states that CWF will be making some budget revisions for 2025-2026 and as a result will need to change our contribution to church camp to a lump sum instead of current contribution of paying 1/4 of camp fees. This will be voted on at CWF September meeting. CWF asked about the possibility of our campers participating in fundraising for camp, i.e. a carwash possibly. CWF is planning a drive-thru beefburger fundraiser in the Fall.
