

NEWS FOR YOU

BRIEFLY FROM THE BOARD:, Kayla Price, Board Secretary

August monthly offering \$5,484.00, August monthly expenses \$10,786.71, August monthly budget amount \$7,458.33. Ashley Carmin Performing Arts Scholarships were awarded to two Carlisle High School students for the fall semester. Going forward, there will be two church representatives counting offering each Sunday. Emma Bingham has added a new QR code to our church website. Communication Committee will meet on Monday 9-22-25. Brief discussion regarding church cleaning. Cleaning day has been scheduled for Saturday, November 8th if you are available to assist! By-law changes reviewed and will be presented at the 2025 Congregational Meeting on Sunday, October 5, 2025 to be voted on by the congregation members. You may get a copy in advance at the church to review before the meeting. Our "Lift Project" funding is now over \$47,000. The board will make a recommendation at the Congregational Meeting to proceed with the lift only at this time as we do not have the funds at this point to proceed with east door and outside ramp, which may take a bit longer to fund. The proposed 2026 Annual Budget was approved by the board, pending the approval of congregation members at the October 5, 2025 meeting. The Nominating Committee submitted 2026 slate of officers to also be approved at the Congregational Meeting on October 5, 2025. Sunday School, Tuesday Bible Study and Wednesday Bible Study (The Chosen) have all started again. Middle River Friends Food Pantry will be the recipient of our September mission donation. Please plan to attend the 2025 Annual Congregational Meeting directly after church on Sunday, October 5, 2025!
